At The Town Hall: This past week GARMS (Governance, Audit, Risk Management and standards) met on Tuesday, looking at the financial sustainability of the Adult Social Care programme and a report from the Corporate Anti-Fraud Team, amongst other things. On Friday 29 November, The Safer Communities Partnership Board met to look at the Violence Reduction Action Plan, including VAWAG, modern slavery and an update on the Barnet Safeguarding Adults Board. Torrington Park and surrounding Area Road Safety Consultation.

The results of the consultation are now in and have been put on to the 'Engage Barnet' website.

A lot of changes have been incorporated into the final version following residents' feedback during the consultation period. These are documented in the report. The proposals include:

A new 20mph zone in the area with measures to reduce speeding, including....

- The introduction of speed cushions on various local roads with the aim to reduce vehicle speeds.
- Build outs and carriageway narrowing in places to reduce vehicle speed
- Uncontrolled crossing points at side roads to provide a safer crossing point for pedestrians
- Introduction of horizontal deflections, carriageway narrowing and surface colour/texture treatment on Torrington Park to reduce vehicle speeds and which is also suitable for the bus route
- Introduction of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) on localised sections of the roads. This aims to reduce parking obstruction and improve visibility especially for vulnerable road users.
