At The Town Hall: This past week Cabinet met on Thursday 5 December to consider the strategy on Keeping Young People Safe: Tacking Child Exploitation 2025-2028. This was the last report of Chris Munday who is retiring as Director of Childrens' Services in Barnet. Cabinet thanked Chris for his ten years of service to the Borough. There was also discussion on a revised policy for Community Assets as well as the annual report on Equalities. Business Planning, included the revised MTFS (Medium Term Financial Strategy) which was discussed in detail, including key headlines and a breakdown of service pressures. The proposals will go out to public consultation from 12 December to 22 January and subsequently back to Cabinet in February, before being presented to full council in March. Next week there will be a further meeting of **GARMS** (Governance, Audit, Risk Management and Standards) on Thursday 12th to receive a report by auditors BDO on the audits of council accounts for 2021/22 and 22/23, as well as those of the Barnet Pension Fund. The Overview & Scrutiny Committee will also be scrutinising the budget at a meeting on the same evening. www.barnet.gov.uk
